THE SOCIETE GENERALE TEAM SPIRIT STRIKES A CHORD WITH LES SIECLES

The *Playing for salle Pleyel* project was revived to mark Societe Generale 150th anniversary. This year, over 250 amateur musicians and choir members among the Group's employees were involved in preparing a concert with the *Les Siècles* Orchestra, conducted by François-Xavier Roth.



For its second event, the *Playing for salle Pleyel* project, which is a unique initiative in the corporate world, brought together over 250 choir members and musicians, all from Societe Generale, at every level of musicianship, and from all business lines and management levels.

To mark the 150th anniversary of the Group, this symphonic ensemble gave three concerts, at Salle Pleyel in Paris on 16 and 17 November, and in Lyon on 18 November, under the direction of François-Xavier Roth, one of the most charismatic and entrepreneurial orchestra conductors of his generation.

The ensemble performed excerpts from around ten works from the major repertoire, including March No. 1 from *Pomp and Circumstance*, by Edward Elgar, *Carmen* by Georges Bizet, *Pavane* by Gabriel Fauré, and *West Side Story* by Leonard Bernstein.

The concerts given by the entire ensemble were the result of over one year of preparations and rehearsals led by the musicians and choirmasters of the *Les Siècles* Orchestra, in rooms made available at the La Défense Head Office.
