

SOCIETE GENERALE RESEARCH GRANT

The Société Générale's History Mission supports scientific research by providing grants to students, young researchers and researchers who are following a university course in history or other subjects (economic science, sociology, architecture, etc.) and who have registered for a 1st or 2nd Masters or PhD in France or abroad.

The History Mission and its scientific committee evaluate and select applicants on presentation of a research project. Priority is given to research that purely concerns the history of Société Générale (business lines, organisation, personnel, internationalisation, architecture, subsidiaries, etc.) from 1864 to the current day. However, broader research or comparative research that includes the history of the Société Générale group are also seen in a favourable light. The applicant is free to choose his or her topic, although you can also select one of those suggested by the History Mission.

You can request a grant at any time during the university year.

Grants vary depending on the level of study and place of residence.
