# Société Générale Corporate & Investment Banking voted number 3 overall in commodity markets by Risk and Energy Risk magazines

Société Générale Corporate & Investment Banking has made a surge in annual commodity rankings published the 12<sup>th</sup> of February 2008 by *Risk* and *Energy Risk* Magazines, voted 3<sup>rd</sup> overall and 1<sup>st</sup> in 13 product categories. In the field of metals, Société Générale Corporate & Investment Banking has climbed to 3<sup>rd</sup> position this year, while keeping its 3<sup>rd</sup> place in oil. In natural gas, the bank has risen to 4<sup>th</sup> position this year (9<sup>th</sup> in 2007) owing to the bank's growing commercial franchise in the US and Canada, demonstrating its global market approach.

In Europe, Gaselys was ranked in the top 5 on every natural gas marketplace. Orbeo won 1<sup>st</sup> place in the European ETS Allowances Trading category.

The survey also confirms Société Générale Corporate & Investment Banking's expertise in the field of commodity structured products. The bank was voted 1<sup>st</sup> for investors for a second year running and 1<sup>st</sup> for corporates for a third year in a row.

The rankings are based on the votes of 1,510 global industry participants: North America 38%, Europe 42%, Asia 17% and others 3%.
